

Literacy:

This half term children will be learning how to use horizontal and diagonal joins in handwriting, choosing when to leave a join.

Develop positive attitudes towards and stamina for writing by writing for different purposes: diary entries, travel brochures and fictional stories.

Writing expanded noun phrases, writing in the present and past tenses correctly and consistently including the progressive form.

Subordination (using when, if, that, or because) and co-ordination (using or, and, or but). We will focus on the following books- Robinson Crusoe and The lighthouse keeper's lunch.

Science- Everyday materials:

- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

- Explore and investigate which material would make the best boat and bucket.

History:

We will be looking at seashores in the past. How people travelled there, what they did for leisure, clothing and different features.



Geography:

- To explore what a seaside is and where in the country they can be found.
- Human and Physical features that can be seen.

Art:

We will be learning how to draw different Seaside objects and animals.
